Job title: Activity Leaders & Activity Leader Specialists (Summer Vacation Courses)

Job summary: Students attending our summer schools receive a combination of 15 hours English language tuition per week and a comprehensive programme of activities and excursions. You will be part of a team of Activity Leaders supervising and leading students during this programme. You may also be required to plan and set up some activities. The activity programme comprises on-campus daytime and evening activities alongside full and half day trips to places of historical and cultural interest.

Activity Leaders work on 13 activity sessions per week.

Activity Leader Specialists in the Performing Arts, Arts & Crafts and Sports lead 3 sessions per week in their area of expertise as part of their 13 weekly sessions.
